WHO NEEDS THEM?



Employees and volunteers who work with or supervise children in the absence of parents. Here at St. John's that includes Clergy, Christian Education director, Sunday Church School teachers and assistants, and volunteers helping with student clubs, pageants, VCS, fundraisers, or student charity events.

WHAT CLEARANCES ARE NEEDED?

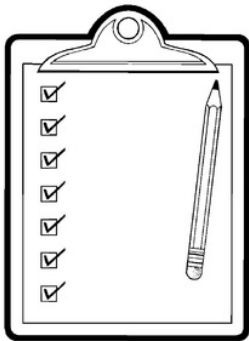


There are 3 types of clearances.

1. PA Child Abuse History Clearance (form CY113) is required. Free for volunteers.
2. Pennsylvania State Police Criminal Record Check is required. Free for volunteers.
3. FBI clearances for volunteers are only required for those who have lived out of the state of Pennsylvania in the last 10 years. Cost is reimbursable. Submit receipt to the church.
